

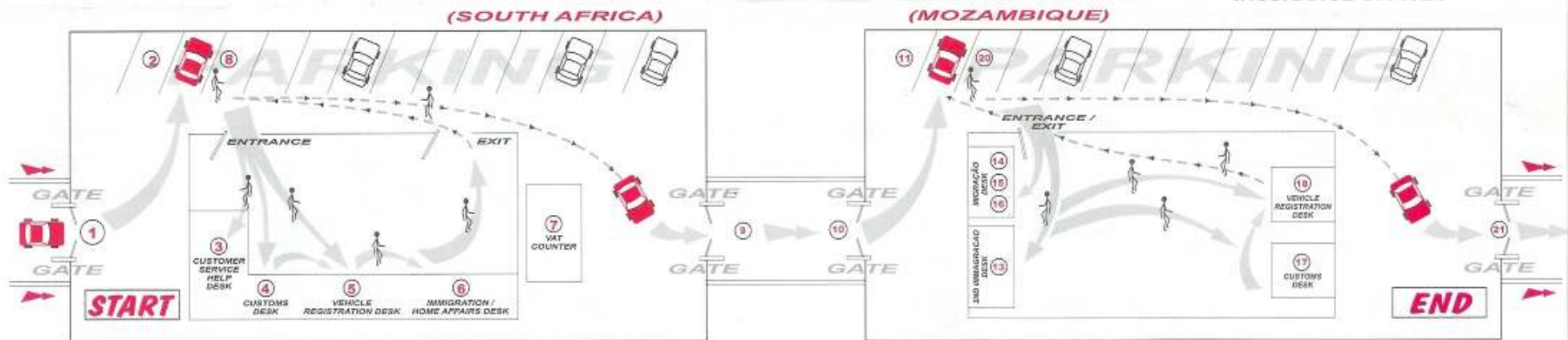
# ENTERING MOZAMBIQUE

## SOUTH AFRICAN FRONTIER

1. Collect your gate pass where the following will be recorded:
  - Car registration and the number of people in the vehicle
2. Park in designated area. All passengers disembark and proceed to the frontier office.
3. If you have any questions go to the Customer Services Help Desk.
4. If you have export goods to declare, go to the Customs Desk where your original invoices must be stamped.
5. The driver of the vehicle reports to the Vehicle Registration desk and presents the original car registration document or an authorising letter, if not the owner of the vehicle.
  - The driver collects form DA 341 and completes it.
  - The driver presents the completed DA 341 form and gate pass to the official at the Car Registration Desk.
  - The official should stamp the form and gate pass.
6. All passengers proceed to the SA Immigration/ Home Affairs Desk with their passports and the gate pass where the passports will be stamped.
7. If you are not a South African citizen and want to reclaim VAT, present the goods and original invoices at the VAT counter for a VAT refund.
8. Embark your vehicle and drive to the gate where you will hand in your gate pass.
9. Drive to the Mozambican Frontier area.

## MOZAMBICAN FRONTIER

10. Enter the gate and collect your gate pass with the following recorded:
  - Your vehicle registration number and number of people in vehicle.
11. Park in the designated area. All passengers disembark and proceed to the frontier office.
12. If you did not have a visa, report to the second Migração desk and apply for a visa. (Non South African and Mozambican Citizens).
13. Report to the first Migração desk with your passport and R17.00 cash, per passenger.
14. Individuals are required to complete a form which you will receive from the immigration official.
15. The passport is stamped, R17.00 is paid and you are reminded to request a receipt.
16. If you have import goods to declare, go to the Customs Desk for the necessary declaration and present the original invoices.
17. The driver of the vehicle reports to the Vehicle Registration Desk, with the original vehicle registration document or an authorising letter, if not the owner of the vehicle.
  - Present DA341 and gate pass at Car Registration Desk
  - The official should stamp the form and your gate pass
- Pay the MTn 26.50 (+/- R7.00) (the stamped form is your receipt). Please ensure that you have the correct cash as small change is not always available.
18. Return to your vehicle. Request an inspection officer to inspect the vehicle and stamp your gate pass.
19. Embark your vehicle, proceed to the gate and hand in your gate pass.
20. You may be stopped for a control inspection along the N4.
21. Drive safely, keep to the speed limits and enjoy the beauty and hospitality of Mozambique and remember: "Lights on Saves lives!"



## SOUTH AFRICAN FRONTIER

8. Enter the gate and collect your gate pass with:
  - Car registration and number of people in vehicle.
9. Park vehicle.
10. All individuals to go to Home Affairs with their passports and the gate pass to have their passports stamped.
11. Should you have anything to declare, go to the Customs Assessment Office. An official will determine how much you should pay in SA Rand.
12. Payment is then made at the Cashier and travellers are to **ensure that they obtain a**
13. Driver of the vehicle is to proceed to the Car Registration Desk with the car vehicle registration form and the gate pass, which will be stamped. (SA registered vehicles form DA341, Mozambican registered vehicles form DA308).
14. Embark from vehicle and proceed to the gate.
15. Hand in your gate pass and proceed through the gate.

# ENTERING SOUTH AFRICA

## MOZAMBIQUE FRONTIER

1. Drive through the gate
2. Park your vehicle and disembark
3. Proceed to Migracao desk
4. Collect a form from the official, fill in and hand to an official with your passport. (Mozambique to pay R12,00). **Always request a receipt.**
5. Have your passport stamped and ask for receipt if applicable. Complete Modelo 10C and pay MTn 26.50 for Mozambican registered vehicles.
6. Should you have anything to declare, go to the customs desk.
7. Return to your vehicle and drive through to the South African frontier.
